Excursions, Incursions and School Camps

Throughout the year students may be involved in class or school excursions or visits by performers. These events are conducted as part of the educational program. Staff are conscious of the cost of such events and, as a result, events are kept to an acceptable level to support school programs. Participation is dependent on online consent and/or payment on Compass before the closing date.

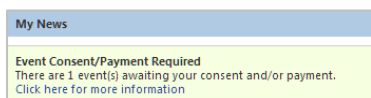
To assist parents an email is sent at the end of each term to alert the parents of the upcoming events for the next term.

Email reminders for outstanding consents and /payments are sent fortnightly and then weekly prior to the due date. Please note Compass online consent/payments close at midnight on the due date.

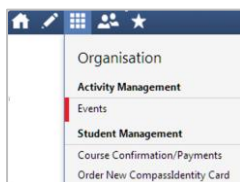
To avoid having to come into the office to sign a paper copy please ensure you pay/consent online before midnight on the due date.

Consent and Payments online through Compass

1. From the Compass home screen, click on the event alert under 'My News' or navigate to 'Events' under the *Organisation* menu item.



2. From the Events page a list of upcoming events and excursions will be displayed. Click the red 'Process Now' button to provide consent and/or payment (depending upon what the event requires).



3. An online payment/consent form will be displayed. Complete all highlighted relevant fields and click the 'Submit Details' button.

Students will not be taken outside the school without online consent with the exception of local walking excursions. Examples of this type of activity could be, but are not limited to, a visit to the Eco Park opposite the school or a short neighbourhood walk to investigate flora, fauna or environment. Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be given the opportunity to participate in the school's camping program.
