#### **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT**

**Uniform** - Summer is on the way and so it is timely to revisit the summer uniform requirements. They may be found on the school website <a href="http://mtmarthaps.vic.edu.au/">http://mtmarthaps.vic.edu.au/</a> under the "Policies" tab or in the Parent Information Booklet under the "Parents" tab. A reminder that while non uniform jumpers/hoodies may be worn to and from school they are not part of the school uniform and so should not be worn while the students are at school. Thank you for your assistance. A reminder that if your child has lost an item, please visit the Lost Property area near the Art Room.

**Triennial Review** - This term the school will begin undertaking preparations for a review of its successes and identifying areas to focus on for future improvement. The review is part of DET processes that occur in every Victorian government school. The review will occur over four days in term one 2024 with a team including an external reviewer, a regional DET staff member, two principals, school council president and school staff examining a range of information. This includes student learning outcomes, survey data, classroom observations and focus group interviews with students, parents, and staff. Findings are incorporated in the school's Strategic Plan which sets goals, targets and an initial set of strategies which are updated each year. Review is an important process to plan the direction for our school's improvement.

**Year Three Camp** - Our Year Three students, staff and a fantastic group of parent volunteers are heading to Somers Camp on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October for three days of fabulous and exciting activities. We hope you all have a wonderful time on your first camp and look forward hearing about their adventures after camp.

**Prep 2024 Information Night** - Last night we have the next in a series of activities for Parents of our 2024 Prep students. The session provided parents/carers with an insight into how they can support their child's transition into school. A highlight of the evening was a fashion parade of the school uniform by some of this year's Prep students. Next week we have the first of our Storytime sessions for our 2024 Preps.

Smile Squad - Smile Squad is a Victorian Government program that provides free dental care to all Victorian government primary and secondary school students. Smile Squad offers free oral health packs, free annual oral health examinations and free follow-up treatment for all students attending Victorian Government schools. Smile Squad will be available to all students for free, even if they do not have a healthcare card or Medicare card, or if they are ineligible for the Commonwealth Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS). There are no out-of-pocket expenses for families. We have been allocated access to this program this term from 23rd October. Below is links to the consent form via a link or QR code. If parents could complete the consent form by 22nd October it will assist the service in knowing how many anticipated patients, they will see at our school.

Free Tutor Service - A new service is being run by the Lions Club of Dromana that provides free tutoring to primary school children on the Mornington Peninsula. This service is aimed at giving children who have fallen behind in recent times, a bit of a boost so they have a chance to fulfill their potential. It is focusing on students from years 4-6. The concept revolves around the fact that on the Peninsula there are many retired teachers who would love to be able to help their community in some way, and at the same time there are many children who could benefit from their experience. All children must be accompanied by an adult and morning tea will be provided.




