PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Triennial Review - This term the school will be undertaking a review of its successes and identifying areas to focus on for future improvement. The review is part of DET processes that occur in every Victorian government school. Usually reviews occur over about four days with a team including an external reviewer, a regional DET staff member, two principals and school staff examining a range of information. This includes student learning outcomes, survey data, classroom observations and focus group interviews with students, parents and staff. Findings are incorporated in the school's Strategic Plan which sets goals, targets and an initial set of strategies which are updated each year. Review is an important process to plan the direction for our school's improvement.

Uniform - Summer is on the way and so it is timely to revisit the Summer uniform requirements. 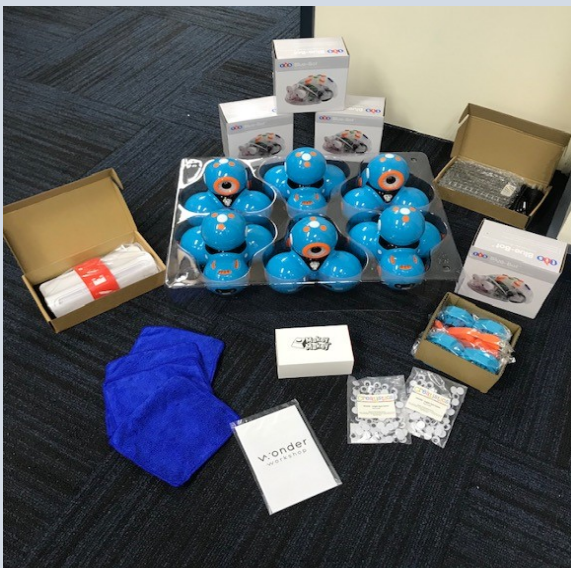


EARN AND LEARN EQUIPMENT HAS ARRIVED

JAPANESE DAY - WEDNESDAY 30TH OCTOBER

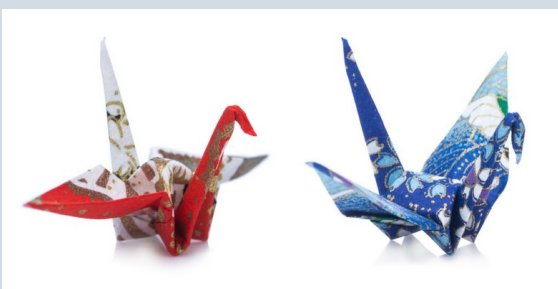

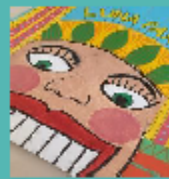
