Mt Martha Primary School strives to empower students to be active learners who make a positive impact in a changing world.

### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

End of term - A reminder that Term Two finishes on Friday 24th June at 2.30pm. Term Three commences on Tuesday 12th July. Monday 11th July is a Student Free Day where staff will be focusing on Building Learning Power - transforms learning and teaching, giving students a language to talk about, understand and grow their learning habits. What it takes to be a good learner, grows a student's learning character and habits, develops the appetite and ability to learn in different ways. This will lead into the work of our Professional Learning Teams in Term Three of learning dispositions of students in Mathematics and is linked to the goals in the school's Annual Implementation Plan.

Prep 2023 Enrolment - A reminder that 2023 Prep Enrolment Forms are now due back, and we will soon be making offers of enrolment. These should be accompanied with a birth certificate, immunisation certificate and proof of address. Forms should now be returned as soon as possible. Enrolment information and forms are available from the Office.

Safe Travel - With winter road conditions now with us it is timely to remind our children of the need for sensible behaviour near or on roads, relevant road rules, safe riding strategies including wearing helmets and use of shared pathways. In addition to road safety messages the students receive from the school, if parents could remind and reinforce safe pedestrian and bike use with their child that would be appreciated. Thank you.

**Assembly** - Our end of term assembly is Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June at 9.10am. A terrific opportunity for students to share their learning and celebrate the efforts of all students in working towards achieving their learning goals.

Reminder - Reports and Student Led Conferences - Written reports for the first semester will be available via Compass on Monday 20th June. Student Led Conferences will be conducted on Tuesday 21st June. These sessions are a fantastic opportunity to share in your child's learning and interests. These Conferences also assist with building relationships between home and school and encourage children to take more responsibility and interest in their own learning. The children will present pieces of their work, talk about the progress of their learning and what they need to focus on next. Bookings can be made up until 8am on Tuesday 21st June (the day of the Conferences). Please be advised that by that date there will be limited time slots available.

It is vital that you are on time for your Student Led Conferences. Teachers will do their absolute best to keep to allocated times, but this is very dependent on parent/s being ready to commence the Conference at the allotted time. Conferences run for 15 minutes and usually are timetabled back-to-back. The teachers and students are developing a schedule that allows all parties (student, teacher, and parent/s) to have the opportunity to contribute to the discussion at the Conference within that 15 -minute time frame. Your assistance in ensuring that our Student Led Conferences schedule runs smoothly would be appreciated.

**Professional Learning Community** - During Term Two our whole school focus on improving literacy outcomes for students from our school's Annual Implementation Plan goal was to improve students' skills and strategies whilst reading within the text. Each year level defined this goal to a more specific goal for their students.

- **Prep:** For students to effectively use segmenting and blending to read simple single syllable words.
- **Year 1:** I can recognise and use consonant blends to solve CCVC words.
- Year 2: For students to retell a story using the beginning, middle and end structure with differentiated levels of detail.
- **Year 3:** For students to use the features of nonfiction texts to summarise.
- Year 4: For students to search for information and language that states or implies the larger message (s) of the text.
- Year 5: For students to improve their ability to summarise a story including important aspects of plot, characters, theme and lesson
- **Year 6:** For students to use comprehension strategies to summarise relevant information. To read a text and be able to summarise the important information from the text.

Yesterday during the Staff Professional Learning session teams shared highly effective teaching and learning strategies and the pre and post assessments used with students to measure student learning growth and the next learning goals for students. In Semester Two the focus of our Professional Learning Community will be on the numeracy goals within the Annual Implementation Plan.
