#### **LUNCH ORDER NEWS**

Starting on the second Monday of Term 4 (October 15) BakeryMade management have indicated that they are willing to extend our Lunch order system to 2 days a week. So, commencing on Monday 15 October parents/carers can now order a lunch order on either Mondays or Fridays if they wish.

The only method for ordering school lunches for your child/ren from BakeryMade is to download the app from the iTunes store or google play – just search for the BakeryMade (all one word) app. Download and install the app and then open it and register as a customer. There are a number of steps to follow. It is important that you provide your home address for billing and not the school address.

No cash is required using this system. Orders are placed, preferably the night before or earlier, but no later than 8am on the day the lunch is to be delivered.


Once the app is open parents will be able to view the sub menus ie. Sandwiches, hot food selections, snacks, pies & pasties, muffins & slices and Gluten free options.


