#### 2021 NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) 2021 for Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 students will be held on Tuesday 11 May, Wednesday 12 May and Thursday 13 May 2021. NAPLAN tests assess student knowledge and skills in Writing, Reading, Language Conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and Numeracy.

The results of the tests provide information for students, parents, teachers and principals which can be used to improve student achievement.

All students are expected to participate in the NAPLAN tests. During test week, catch-up tests will be available for individual students who are absent on test days. These students may undertake catch-up tests on the days in the test week after the scheduled test, up to and including Friday 14 May 2021.

Exemptions may be granted to students with significant intellectual disabilities and to students who have been learning English for less than one year.

If your child is eligible for support due to disability, has an exemption or you have any concerns about your child participating you should discuss this with his/her teacher prior to the tests. Parental consent is required before any support due to disability or exemption is granted.

Students may be withdrawn from NAPLAN by their parent or carer. This is a matter for consideration by parents and carers in consultation with the school. If, after consultation, you decide to withdraw your child, you must sign a Student Withdrawal form. These forms are available at the school.

Later in the year you will receive your child's personal NAPLAN report. The report will describe your child's particular skills in Reading, Writing, Language Conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and Numeracy. The report will also show how your child performed in relation to national minimum standards. These describe the minimum acceptable standards for students across Australia.

We will be holding 2 different events for 9/10, 11 and 12/13yr old races:

- 1 COMPETITION: Competitors are to complete the set amount of km/laps for their age group.
- **2 FUN RUN**: This race is a modified race, it is a 1km event which allows students to complete the number of laps they are capable of. This is a non-competitive race and will cater for students who wish to walk the track.

The top 10 students from Yr 2 - 6 in each event will represent our school at the District level at Penbank School on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> May.

The track route: Start far end of oval on track, running around the track, beside gym, across basketball courts, out back gate and down Melrose Drive. The runners then continue along Normanby onto Glenisla Drive. Finally they run up the hill and into the staff carpark back onto the oval to finish or start 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> lap.

Parents are encouraged to attend and support the children. The sports leaders and students from Mornington Secondary College will act as 'Hares' for each race so the children have something to follow if they are not sure of the route. The track will also be supervised by our teachers and Secondary College Students.
