PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

COVID -19 Update - Extension of Remote Learning - Based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, all schools in Victoria will continue with remote and flexible learning until Tuesday 27th July. We really look forward to welcoming the students back onsite on Wednesday 28th July.

We have finished our first week of remote learning and I would like to thank everyone for your work in the remote learning program while balancing all your other commitments. Year level program information will continue to be sent out via Compass, See Saw and Google Classroom. Year levels and teachers will update student work tasks and hold regular video conferencing via Webex. Specialist teacher lessons and webex sessions will also be provided. Teachers may adjust the tasks and methods of delivery during the week.

Again, please do not hesitate to continue to use the support and guidance of your child's teacher to assist in meeting their learning and well being needs.

Semester One Reports and Student Led Conference - Unfortunately, we have had to <u>cancel</u> our Student Led Conference Day next **Tuesday 27**th **July.** It will no longer be a pupil free day. The remote learning program will continue as usual on this day. Semester One student reports will still be available on Compass from **Monday 26**th **July**. Parents will be offered the opportunity to make arrangements to discuss their child's report with the teacher/s.

On site Supervision - To assist in slowing the spread of COVID-19, all students who can learn from home must learn at home. With recent outbreaks occurring in schools and subsequent quarantining of contacts and school closures we can see how this remains another important control measure.

As with other remote learning periods, our school will provide on-site supervision for students in the following DET categories:

- Children where both parents and/or carers are <u>authorised workers</u> who cannot work from home, work for an essential provider and where no other supervision arrangements can be made:
 - *Where there are two parents/carers, both must be authorised workers, working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.
 - *For single parents/ carers, the authorised worker must be working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.


