PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear parents and carers

School Council elections 2022 - A reminder that the closing date for nominations has been extended and now close at 4pm today, Thursday 24th February. Remaining vacancies will be filled by co option at the first meeting of the new School Council.

COVID Information - We have had a few adjustments to settings to assist in the management of the COVID outbreak. Rapid Antigen Testing has been extended until the end of term. Again we will distribute test kits to you once we have received them. Our students in Years Three to Six are still required to wear face masks indoors unless they have an exemption. From next week adults will no longer be required to QR code in when entering school buildings. Adults will still be required to wear masks indoors unless they have an exemption. Where we are notified of a positive test result a Compass post will continue to be sent at the end of the day to the parents/carers of the year level/s effected. CLASS PARENT CONTACT NEWS

Class Parent Contact Register Information

Each year your student's classroom teacher creates a class directory, providing contact information for other families in the class. This is purely voluntary and you must inform your student's teacher if you wish to be a part of the class directory. The advantage of such information is to provide easy access to contact information (mainly phone numbers) for the students in your class to assist with planning after school play dates, catch ups over the term holidays, birthday parties or when encouraging new friendships. It also provides an avenue for new families to initiate contact with other families from your class. Once your classroom teacher has collected the information from everyone that would like to be a part of the list it will be distributed either as a hard copy or via compass. Remember that you must let your student's teacher know if you wish to be included and provide the best contact information.

Class Representative

Teachers will also be requesting that one parent volunteer to be the Class Representative. This is a role that has been developed to help coordinate parents in the class to assist with various events.

The role may include:

- Liaising with the SEC to support one or two major activities or whole school events, for example, Footy Day, Jogathon, fundraisers, Gold for Green Day
- Organising activities to bring the classroom community together, for example, meeting at the Eco Park after school, a family afternoon/evening at the beach or estuary
- Inviting parents to assist with class events specific to year levels such as excursions, movie-making, swimming, beach program, Expos, Year 6 Graduation or activities in class
- And generally assisting the classroom teacher liaise with parents regarding special events.
