Dear Parents/Carers

Jerry Gaiser and Hugh O'Brien were the successful nominees for the DET employee vacancies. The next School Council meeting is our AGM followed by our first meeting of the new School Council providing an opportunity to thank retiring members, co opt for Community Members and welcome our new members to School Council.

Whole of School Photos - A reminder that school photos will be taken next Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March. Please ensure all students are in uniform on the day. The photographers have advised that the individual photos may be ordered after seeing proofs however, if parents would like a 'family photo' which means having siblings combined, they need to pre-order <u>before</u> 4.30pm Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March (the day before Whole School Photo Day). Important ordering information is included in this newsletter.

**SEC "Get To Know You Night"-** SEC are running a "Get To Know You Night" **next Wednesday 3**" **March at 7pm**. It will be a great chance to hear about the SEC and catch up with other parents. Looking forward to seeing you there.

**Meet The Teacher** - It was great to see so many parents taking the opportunity to share information with the teachers at the Meet the Teacher evening on Tuesday and Wednesday. Establishing new relationships with class teachers and open lines of communication is important in the learning partnership we enjoy between students, parents, teachers and other school staff.

**Bike Safety** - Riding a bike to and from school is a healthy travel option. Early in the year it is good to remind our bike riders of road rules, safe riding strategies including wearing helmets and use of shared pathways. In addition to road safety messages the students receive from the school, if parents could remind and reinforce safe bike use with their child that would be appreciated. We have received some concerning reports of some bike riders engaging in some high risk behaviour. Thank you.

**Uniform** - Summer is with us and we can still expect some warm weather but with a few cooler mornings. It is timely to revisit the Summer uniform requirements. A reminder that while non uniform jumpers/ hoodies may be worn to and from school they are not part of the school uniform and so should not be worn while the students are at school. **Sunsmart** - A reminder that all children are required to wear a school approved Sunsmart wide brimmed or bucket hat during lunchtime and recess breaks and when doing sport and physical education outside from February to May 1st and from September 1st through to the end of December. Parents are encouraged to provide their children with their own sunscreen for further protection.

## **UPDATED COVID INFORMATION**

A reminder to all parents of updated COVID-19 measures:

#### **Updated COVID Information -**

A reminder to all parents of updated COVID-19 measures:

- Face masks must be carried and worn by individuals 12 years old or older (except our students on site) when indoors
   and also outdoors where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Parents are now allowed back on site however social distancing (1.5 metre distance) between adults remains a key
  control measure and <u>must</u> continue to be practiced including when dropping off or picking up students.
- Unwell students should <u>not</u> be sent to school or remain at school if symptoms (even mild symptoms) appear during the
  day or they become unwell. Parents will be contacted to collect unwell students who will be supervised while isolated
  from other students. Parents should follow the latest DHHS and medical practitioner advice as to testing and
  quarantining.
- The school will continue to practise strict hygiene protocols and enhanced school cleaning procedures are also in place.
- Drinking fountains are available but students may choose to bring their own named water bottle.
- If visitors/parents/carers intend to spend longer than 15 minutes on site then they are required to sign in at the Office.
- Density limits do not apply in classrooms and other spaces students use. A density limit of 1 person to 2 square metres
  does apply to any spaces and activities being attended by staff, parents/carers and other visitors and then applies to all
  persons in the space including students, staff and visitors.
- Each family should regularly check the list of public exposure sites in Victoria (where a person with COVID-19 has attended), and if anyone in the family has attended a site at the times listed, follow the instructions given.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

## CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors, excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students
- \$225 for secondary school students

#### **HOW TO APPLY**


New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef

If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in 2020, you do not need to complete an application form in 2021 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools in 2021 or you did not apply in 2020.
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2021.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.
