### **MURAL PROJECT**

You may have noticed that the school has a rather large new mural. The mural is located on the Administration building wall near the main gate. The school engaged the services of local artist Tony Sowersby to work with a group of our Year 6 students to design and produce the mural. The mural depicts a range of animals found in Port Phillip Bay as its centrepiece and a number of unique Australian animals form the border of the mural.

The Year 6 students met with Tony twice before commencing work on the mural. Their ideas for the mural were incorporated into the final design. The students then spent time in 3 groups over a period of 3 days painting the final design on 6 large panels. The final stage was completed on Tuesday last week when Tony returned to place the mural on the wall.

Each year the Year 6 students run their Market day. Monies raised from the market are divided equally into three parts. A third goes to a charity that the Year 6 students select. Another third goes towards the cost of their final Year 6 celebration and the final third of the monies raised goes to a lasting pledge for the school. In previous years the Year 6 cohort have funded the 3 flagpoles in Area C, the You Can Do It signage near the school crossing and some seating in Area C under the trees. This year the money they have raised has funded the new mural. All great additions to our school grounds.
