'i sea i care' AMBASSADORS' REPORT

On the 20th of August the 'i sea i care' ambassadors went on a drive to the Mornington Wetlands, where we looked at the health of the water and tiny creatures (invertebrates) that live in the wetlands. We learnt about methods used to test the health of the water and whether or not the creatures there are tolerant, which means they can live in any conditions or sensitive, which means they are very picky about where they live. After that we headed on to the litter traps, which make sure that rubbish doesn't get into the wetlands and then continue to the beach. Then we were given a bucket and tongs and sent off to collect rubbish. At first we couldn't find ANYTHING but in the end we collected one whole bucket full!

We then ventured on, to Mothers Beach, where we went on a nurdle hunt. We learnt about how nurdles are tiny balls of plastic, which get melted down into other shapes to make the plastic containers such as water buckets. However, these nurdles are deadly to all the marine life if they find their way into our waterways and onto our beaches, as they are small and can easily be swallowed.

Another activity we did was using pictures of the tails (flukes) of humpback whales to identify them. A whale's fluke is like a human's fingerprint, every one is different and how marine biologists identify them. We had a sheet of different whale tails and we had to match pictures of the tail where from the same whale. Some of them were really easy to compare but others were very similar and were a little harder.

A volunteer from the Dolphin Research Institute also taught us how to use the binoculars they use tosspot dolphins. Unfortunately because of the windy conditions we couldn't see any,










