#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

**Remote Learning-** we have nearly finished our second week of remote learning and once again I would like to thank everyone for your work in implementing the program. We hope it is becoming just a little easier as remote learning routines are re-established. We appreciate that there is a difference between home and school learning and that the moods and motivation of children can change. Flexibility can often be a useful strategy. Please contact your child's teacher for assistance if required.

As control measures at school we are temperature checking students attending onsite prior to the commencement of the school day and have maintained our etiquette for sneezing/coughing/nose blowing and our hygiene protocols for everyone. Students who attend primary school for onsite supervision are not required to wear a face covering but may choose to. No student who is unwell or displaying cold or 'flu' like symptoms may attend school and parents/carers will be asked to collect them if the student is onsite. In addition, all students who can learn from home must learn at home. The exception is for vulnerable children or children of essential workers on days when they are not able to be supervised at home and no other childcare arrangements can be made. We are also enforcing social distancing for adults on site, wearing face coverings and a reminder that parents/carers should only enter the school site for essential business.

Since resuming this term we have seen multiple school closures in response to positive covid-19 test results. These school closures are to give time for deep cleaning and contact tracing and this may take several days. No one is allowed on site while this occurs. Information regarding the need to close can be given to schools at very short notice and subsequently another short timeframe to notify families.

Once again, thanks for your assistance as we work to continue the learning of our students and keep the community safe.

**2021 Prep Enrolments**- A reminder that 2021 Prep Enrolment forms are now overdue. Enrolment forms for siblings of students already attending the school are also required as soon as possible. Forms should be accompanied with a birth certificate, immunisation certificate and proof of address. Submitting your enrolment forms now assists our planning for next year and to ensure your child's involvement in future transition activities when they are able to be run. Thank you.

**Parent Teacher Interviews-** a reminder also that parents have the opportunity to discuss their child's Semester One report which were available via Compass last Thursday. With the current restrictions interviews will have to be undertaken remotely. Please email your child's teacher via their gmail to arrange an interview time.



Principal's Report continued,

**Attendance-** Parents of students who are learning from home should continue to use the Compass absence function to record if their child is not participating in the learning program for that day. Teachers will monitor student work and follow up if students have not engaged in the learning tasks. Students who are eligible to attend onsite will have their attendance recorded at school.
