"Read More In May"- I hope everyone enjoyed "Read More In May". Our aim is to encourage regular reading for enjoyment, information and as a skill that is a cornerstone of education.

Lost Property - A quick reminder to check our lost property "collection" located near the Art Room. Our collection of lost items has grown during the term. We would love to reunite them with their owners!

First Aid - We are currently updating our Asthma Action Plans and Student Health Support Plans for our students. Both of these forms are a requirement at Mount Martha Primary School. Students that have plans requiring an update have been posted. Please read through the Student Health Support Plan form, amend if necessary and return to the school at your earliest convenience. A finalised copy will be sent out to you for signing, please return to school and retain one for your own records. The Asthma Action Plan is to be issued by your doctor and returned to the school for our records. If your child no longer requires an Asthma Plan we will require this in writing from your GP before it can be removed from our records.

From Monday June 3rd first aid notification will go via a Compass notifications to parents, rather than a note in your child's bag. The email will be sent after the child has left sick bay. Further information on this process in the newsletter.

Forms should be accompanied with a birth certificate, immunisation certificate and proof of address. Bookings will close at 8am on Tuesday 25 June (the day of the conferences). If you have not made a booking by that time you will need to contact the teacher directly to arrange a time for your conference. The office Administration staff will not be able to assist you with this matter as they will be unaware of the availability of individual teachers.

To make a booking log on to Compass after 8.30am on Monday 17 and you will able to make bookings by clicking the "Student Led Conference" button next to your child's photo on their Compass homepage, or by clicking the Dashboard Alert at the top of their Newsfeed.

SICK BAY ATTENDANCE NOTIFICATIONS NOW ON COMPASS

Effective Monday 3rd June, parents/guardians will receive a Compass email notification for any Sickbay attendance. Any incidents such as a bump to the head, suspected fractures or any injury requiring further medical assessment from a medical practitioner etc. will necessitate the school contacting the parents/guardians by phone.

An example of the email message you may receive from Sickbay is listed below:

Book Review Competition




