PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

COVID-19 Update - Extension of Remote Learning - The Victorian Government has announced arrangements for schools in Victoria from and including Friday 4th June.

Based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, all schools in metropolitan Melbourne will continue with remote and flexible learning until Thursday 10th June. This includes our school. Unless otherwise advised, students are expected back at school on Friday 11th June.

We have nearly finished our first week of remote learning and I would like to thank everyone for your work in the remote learning program. Updated Year level information will again be sent out via Compass to continue the remote student learning program. To allow routines to develop, next week's program can be expected to be similar to this week. Year levels and teachers will update student work tasks and hold regular video conferencing via Webex. Specialist teacher lessons and Webex sessions will also be provided. Teachers may adjust the tasks and methods of delivery during the week.

Again, please do not hesitate to continue to use the support and guidance of your child's teacher to assist in meeting their learning and well being needs.

On site Supervision - In order to assist in slowing the spread of COVID-19, all students who can learn from home <u>must</u> learn at home.

Existing arrangements for on-site supervision of vulnerable children and the children of authorised workers continue to be in place. As with other remote learning periods, our school will provide on-site supervision for students in the following DET designated categories:

- * Children where both parents and/or carers are authorised workers who cannot work from home, work for an essential provider and where no other supervision arrangements can be made:
- Where there are two parents/carers, both must be authorised workers, working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision
- For single parents/ carers, the authorised worker must be working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.
- * Children experiencing vulnerability, including:
- children in out-of-home care
- children deemed vulnerable by a government agency, funded family or family violence service, and is assessed as requiring education and care outside the family home
- children identified by a school or early childhood service as vulnerable, including via referral from a government agency, or funded family or family violence service, homeless or youth justice service or mental health or other health service.

For eligible students the DET attendance application <u>must</u> be completed and submitted to <u>mount.martha.ps@edumail.vic.gov.au</u> as soon as possible to provide information on the required days for tomorrow and the following week. This is crucial for our planning. Our Outside School Hours Care service will be in operation with the usual booking arrangements in place.

Thank you once again for your understanding and support as we continue to implement COVID-Safe practices at our school.


