PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Prep 2023 Transition - Next Thursday 10th November we will be having a 2023 Prep Families Afternoon Tea from 4pm - 5.30pm. The event will take place in the amphitheatre and oval. The focus of this event is to assist in familiarising our new Prep students with the school and an opportunity for parents and staff to connect. A group of our Year Six Student Leaders run lots of exciting activities for the children. Afternoon tea is provided by the school. All 2023 Prep Families are welcome!

Victorian Water Safety Certificate - Next week Year 6 students will be commencing a five-day swimming program designed to build skills as outlined in the Victorian Water Safety Certificate. These skills are extremely valuable for our students to develop and refine as well as meet the prescribed skill requirements to receive the Victorian Water Safety Certificate.

National Assessment Program Science Literacy Field Trial - Around 3,200 Year 6 and Year 10 students from approximately 128 Government, Catholic and independent schools in metropolitan, rural and remote locations will participate in the NAP - Science Literacy field trial. A random sample of schools was drawn from across each state and territory in Australia. A sample of students within each of these schools was selected to complete the field trial. Students in 6C were selected for the sample, today they participated in a world-class online assessment designed by education experts in science literacy. The online assessment is intended to test student's level of science knowledge, understanding and skills. There are separate tests for Year 6 and Year 10 students. The purpose of the field trial is to evaluate potential questions for use in the 2023 NAP - Science Literacy main study. The field trial is about testing the questions, not about testing individual students, or their ability.

Recap of Previous Newsletter Articles

Changes to COVID Settings in School - You may be aware that the Victorian Government has announced changes to the COVID-19 isolation requirements. This means that from yesterday at 11.59pm on Wednesday 12 October, the mandatory orders around isolation for people with COVID-19 have ended and instead we move to health advice and recommendations for people with COVID-19 or COVID-19-like symptoms. Our school will continue to adhere to the Department of Health's recommendations to ensure that our school remains a safe environment for our staff and students.

The Department of Health strongly recommends that students and school staff:

- who test positive to COVID-19 stay home and isolate for 5 days and do not attend school after 5 days if they are still symptomatic
- who are symptomatic but have not tested positive not attend school. This does not include students with pre-existing conditions such as hay fever.

Parents and carers are recommended to continue to report their child having COVID-19 to both the school and the Department of Health.

We will, however, no longer report occurrences of positive cases to the school community. We ask parents and carers to continue to remain vigilant in preventing COVID-19 transmission. Any student who is unwell should continue to remain at home. This is about keeping students healthy and well in our school and reducing the spread of both COVID-19 and other respiratory diseases. Free Rapid Antigen Tests are available at the school for those who need them. Parents and carers will be contacted if their child shows symptoms while at school. Students who wish to wear a mask should continue to do so. To keep our school as safe as possible, we will also continue to use air purifiers and other COVID-19 prevention measures. Thanks for your continued efforts to keep our school community safe and well.

Student Free Day - We have scheduled our Professional Practice Day for Term Four on **Friday November 18th** for all staff. Students will therefore not be required to attend school on this day. Our OHSCP will be available on this day. More information is available in the Banksia Bulletin. Bookings close on **Friday 11th November** at 6pm.



We're excited to announce that Mount Martha Primary School is one of 110 childcare centres, schools, Scouts and Girl Guides groups, and youth groups to receive a 2022 Victorian Junior Landcare and Biodiversity Grant.

Delivered through Landcare Australia's Junior Landcare program, the grants provide young people with the opportunity to engage in outdoor, hands-on biodiversity focused projects or learning activities that encourage them to value and actively care for Victoria's biodiversity and natural environment.




