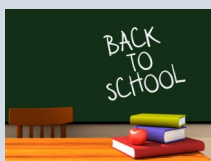

Parents will be able to logon to Compass at that time (or anytime afterwards), click on the "Reports" tab near the top of the screen and click on "2018 – Semester 1" to view the report. Parents will also be able to view/print/save both Semester 1 & 2 reports from 2017.

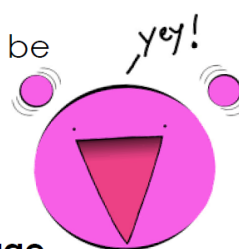

Lastly: to the whole SEC and TT committee - we collaborated, deliberated and in the end, created an event that we should be proud of.

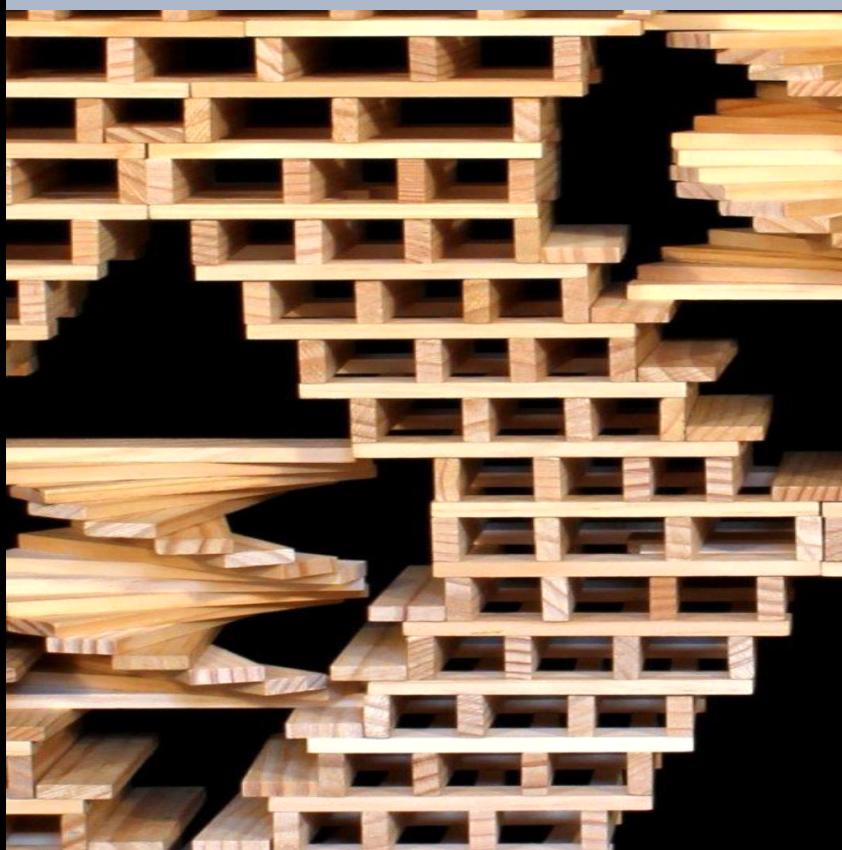
